Fluid Bear Kit Instructions



Getting Started

Step 1

Set Up Your Station

- Lay a table cloth over a plate or tray on your work surface.
- Place art box contents on the table with a clear space for creating.
- Put on your gloves and place bear on to the covered plate.
- Shake any paint bottles that are single-colour.



Step 2

Choose a Technique:

Marbling Technique

In your cup, pour ½-inch layers of paint on top of each other. Keep colours separate and do not mix to avoid muddy tones. Repeat each colour 2–3 times (recommended to repeat the order provided from left to right in your kit). Layer contrasting colours for the best effect with only colours next to each other that could potentially mix well. Ex. white can mix with anything. The first colour you layer in your cup tends to be most dominant.



Defined Colour Technique

Drizzle paints one at a time straight from the bottles on to the bear. Aim each colour onto the unpainted areas to keep them distinct.

Combine Techniques

- Start with a layered pour for a marbled base.
- Add extra pops of colour on top from the straight from the bottles.
- Use a stick or spoon to scoop swirls from tray onto any small missed spots.



Step 3

Add Finishing Touches:

Optional Decor

Glitter:

Take a small pinch in your palm and sprinkle like salt over your bear moving your hand and slowly releasing over top. For a soft sparkle effect all over, blow gently from your palm towards areas you would like to add glitter to.

Gold/Metal Leaf:

Tear small pieces and press them onto wet paint using a clean popsicle stick. Let dry and use a clean brush to dust off textured areas.

Step 4

Let it Dry for at least 24 hours:

Move your bear out of the paint puddle by inserting the popsicle sticks under the arms to lift and shift it to a flat surface. Leave your bear to dry for 24 hours in a safe, dust-free area. For keychain, clip the loop to a hanger over a bag to catch drips. Optionally, place cup behind and rest loop on it allowing it to stand to dry. Option to add a Gloss Finish once dry.
